

DAILY ROUTINE

- Before School (Homeroom Only)
 - When you hear the whistle, bell, stop what you are doing
 - Return all equipment back to where it belongs
 - Line up quickly and quietly
 - Hands, feet, objects to yourself
 - Wait for Mrs. Pikul to pick you up
- Entering the classroom
 - Line up outside of the classroom against the wall and wait for Mrs. Pikul to let you in the classroom

 - Stay seated until everyone in your group has finished the bell work. ONE person from your group will turn in the groups bell work.
 - Choose ONE person from your group to gather necessary materials for the lesson today.
 - Sit quietly and wait for instruction to begin.
- When is it appropriate to leave your seat?
 - Down time- when the teacher is not instructing students, or students are involved in a discussion, where listening is required.
- Leaving the classroom
 - Choose ONE person from your group to return all of the supplies to the same spot that you got them from.
 - Check the floor around you for any trash or lost belongings.
 - Place all personal items into your backpack.
 - Stand behind your desk and wait to be dismissed.
